Accommodation at the Country Club Resort is available from \$169 per night for a Deluxe room. The villas are equipped with kitchenette/kitchen facilities and are located 800 metres (about a 15 minute walk) from the Country Club Resort. A complementary shuttle runs between the Resort and the Villas every 20 minutes.

A full Buffet Breakfast is available at the Resort for \$22 per person per day or a Continental Breakfast is available at \$18 per person per day. A Breakfast Box is also available at \$12.50 for those staying at the Villas.

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

Temperature in Launceston at this time of year ranges from an average minimum of 5 deg. C to an average maximum of 15 deg. C but can be over 20 deg. C, so layered clothing is recommended. An Umbrella or spray jacket in case of wet weather would also be advisable.
A shuttle bus service running from Launceston airport to hotels is available at a cost of \$18 per person. Alternatively taxi from the airport to the Country Club would cost about \$35.
