



Garden bed 22: Palm Grove Garden bed. This large garden follows the eastern side of Kareena Creek from the Main Bridge to the Duck Ponds. It encompasses a large palm grove, including a major stand of Bangalow Palm (*Archontophoenix cunninghamiana*) and ends at the cascade down from the Duck Ponds to Kareena Creek. A few camellias are being established in this Garden bed.
